
# INLAND NORTHWEST CORVAIR CLUB'S

JUNE 12-14 COEUR D'ALENE, IDAHO



The 2009 Econorun is being held in conjunction with the Car d'Alene car show - a major nostalgia event with a 50's theme and about 600 street rods and classic cars. This is a walking-street show in Coeur d'Alene's historic downtown and many thousands of spectators and participants come from all corners of the Pacific Northwest and Canada for the event. In addition, the Coeur d'Alene area offers myriad tourist activities and great family fun if you wish to include the Econorun in a family vacation. There's even "Silverwood" a full-fledged theme park just north of town.

- 3) Hotel Reservation: If you wish to stay at the host hotel (recommended) please contact the Riverbend Inn in Post Falls, ID at (208)\_773-3583. Mention the Corvair club for the special \$69.99/ n rate. You may extend your stay on either side of the weekend for the same rate. Make your reservation ASAP. All of the area hotels usually SELL OUT for the Car d'Alene event weekend.

#### **Venues and Directions:**

#### Host Hotel

<u>Location: Riverbend Inn, Post Falls, Idaho (208) 773-3583</u> (\$69.99/n) June 12th afternoon – June 14<sup>th</sup> morning (2 nights)

<u>Directions:</u> Take US Interstate 90 to Idaho exit#2 "Pleasant View Rd". Go south on Pleasant View one short block to "Riverbend Ave" and turn right, go about 100 ft, then turn right into the hotel parking area. If you are in an oversized vehicle (motorhome or trailer), oversized parking is just past the hotel in the east end of the outlet mall parking area.

• **Friday night party** / cruise / dinner (\$10 per person) 6-9pm Cruise ticket included with show registration or \$10 for cruise-only.

Location: First Presbyterian Church 512 E. Lakeside Ave. Cd'A.

About eight city blocks are cordoned off for the "Cruise". We have arranged a private party on the cruise route including limited in/out privileges to the cruise.

<u>Directions</u>: Interstate 90 to exit #14 "15th Street". Go 1-mile south on 15th to Sherman Avenue. Turn right on Sherman then right on 8th. 8th becomes Lakeside. Lakeside to 6th; right on 6th and right into party/parking area. Our party is on the West side of the Church. YOU WILL NEED YOUR CAR D'ALENE WINDSHIELD PASS TO GET PAST THE CHECK-IN AT SHERMAN and 10th. If you don't have a cruise pass or are driving a vehicle newer than 1972, you must park in the residential area north of Lakeside avenue.

<u>Saturday car show</u> (\$35 must register before June-4, price includes Friday night cruise ticket)

<u>Location: Downtown Coeur d'Alene 7am-4pm</u> – city streets for about eight blocks are cordoned off. We have two blocks on Lakeside Avenue for our cars. We provide people's choice judging for our cars plus we are included in the overall show judging.

<u>Directions:</u> Depart host hotel at approximately 6:30am. Before entering the show area, we will gather at "Petersons Family Foods" a grocery store located at 12<sup>th</sup> and Sherman. At 7am, we will relocate as a group to our assigned blocks on Lakeside Avenue; probably near the church. <u>Please have your WINDHIELD</u>

PASS or you will not be able to enter the show area. Late arrivals MAY be able to park with the group, but there will only be a handful of extra spaces available so for maximum enjoyment, please enter with the main group at 7. If for some reason you don't have your Car d'Alene windshield pass and packet, there will be a registration desk at about 8<sup>th</sup> and Sherman where you can pick it up.

<u>Directions:</u> (From Host Hotel): Interstate 90 east to exit 12 (Highway 95). South on Highway 95 1.8 miles to "Upriver Drive" Turn right on Upriver drive and go west 2.4 miles to 5615 Highland Drive. (Upriver Drive changes name to Highland Drive. Once you turn off of Hwy 95, there are no more turns to make) Tel (208)765-2360. Driveway will be marked.

### Sunday road trip & museum

<u>Location:</u> Bird Museum of Aviation and Invention, Sagle, ID. Museum admission is free. Catered box lunch will be available for \$10 each -please include this amount with your registration if you would like lunch there.

<u>Directions</u>: From host hotel travel east on I-90 to Coeur d'Alene, Idaho (approximately 10 miles), take Sandpoint/ HWY 95 exit (#12). Go left (North) approximately 34 miles to Sagle Road (across from Conoco station). Turn right on Sagle road, travel 11.8 miles and turn left onto Bird Ranch Road which leads you to Bird Aviation Museum and Invention Center.

## OFFICIAL ECONORUN MILEAGE FORM AND RULES

Turn-in this form when you check in at the host hotel. Look for an "ECONORUN MILEAGE AWARD" BOX.

The Econorun operates on the "honor" system. There is no set course or route that you must follow. You simply record your starting and ending odometer readings and the fuel you purchase on the form below. The only requirement is that your "econorun" is at least 100 miles.

#### Instructions:

- 1) Fill in your starting odometer reading and <u>completely</u> fill your fuel tank at the beginning of your desired 100+ mile segment. (Be sure the tank is full)
- 2) When you wish to conclude your 100 mile + segment, refuel to a full tank to the same level as the starting tank and record your odometer reading and the fuel added.

If you encounter any hardship along the way, please write it up in detail and submit it with this form. Remember to follow all the rules and regulations of the road. Drive safely!
